In the beginning a "God created the heavens" and the earth (Gen 1:1 NIV)



The following article is something that caught my attention because it began with the question "Will you take the Prayer Dare"? As I read it, I thought I would share it as something that might challenge others in prayer. The article was written to spotlight a book named the "Prayer Dare" written by Ron Kincaid. Again, maybe it will challenge others to deepen their prayer life. (Article below from www.BeliefNet.com)

When we're in a tough spot, we're likely to pray more. Most people understand that prayer is important, for it is one way we can connect to God. But most people confess that they don't pray enough. Why don't we pray more? "My guess," writes author Ron Kincaid, "is that it is because we don't realize how important prayer is, we aren't quite sure how to pray, or because we don't experience answers to our prayers." Here are ten of his secrets to praying more effectively.

- 1. You Have to Ask (James 4:2): It probably goes without saying that if we want God to answer our prayers, we must pray. God can certainly meet all our needs without us praying, but the Bible is clear that He wants us to ask. God insists that we pray, because He knows that when we ask, we will be more likely to give Him the glory.
- 2. <u>Get Alone with God (Matthew 6:6)</u>: Jesus taught that when we pray, we should do so in secret before God, not in public so that we're seen by others. One of the weaknesses in the Church today is that we have abandoned this practice of getting alone with God to devote ourselves to prayer.
- 3. <u>Pray with Confidence (Hebrews 4:15-16)</u>: The author of Hebrews said that we are to approach the throne of grace with confidence, so we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.
- 4. <u>Corporate Praise (Acts 4:24-31)</u>: Praise has even greater power when it is entered into with other believers. The Early Church faced severe persecution, but when they joined their voices in praise to God, the power of God was released.
- 5. <u>Pray with Humility (Luke 7:6-7)</u>: A centurion, a Roman officer, asked Jesus to heal his servant. As important as he probably was in the community, he didn't consider himself worthy for Jesus to come to his house. He didn't come demanding but humbly.
- 6. <u>Pray God's Promises (Nehemiah 1:8-9)</u>: We can claim God's promises. When we ask for requests that God has already promised to grant us, we increase the likelihood of praying with confidence. Just look at what God did for Nehemiah.
- 7. <u>Pray with Faith (Luke 7:6-9)</u>: God is impressed by people who pray with faith. Jesus promised that God will answer when we pray with faith.
- 8. <u>Pray with Desperation (2 Chronicles 20:12-13)</u>: Often our prayers are not answered because we have not come to the end of our rope, where our only hope is in God. Desperation puts us in a place where we have to turn to God in prayer.
- 9. <u>Pray for Our Leaders (1 Timothy 2:1-2)</u>: God expects us to pray for our leaders so that we might have peace and so that things will go well for us and our country.
 - 10. <u>Pray in Response to God's Promptings (1 Thessalonians 5:19)</u>: Prayer is a two-way process involving talking and listening. We talk to God in prayer, and we listen to God and do what the Holy Spirit prompts us to do.

So, let's have a heart and fill the Food Barrel in the narthex.


