"Jesus on The Main Line" *June 2015*

Spirit and Truth


Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth." (John 4:23-24 NIV)

"Worship does God's Story." We finished a series on authentic worship and just celebrated the gift of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost. Now what? We see Christ; tell us that the true followers will worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth. To do this there are a few things we need to do in preparation for a spirit filled worship.

- 1). Know the Word As Christians we believe that the bile is our Rule of Faith. But interestingly, about 76% of church members do not know what the bible says, does not understand it, and/or has not read through it. This is troubling, because how can a believer grow, disciple, and reach out if they do not know the Word. We should always have the passion and the desire to go deeper into the Word. Luckily, with our partnership with RightNow Media, it is convenient to dive deeper.
- 2). Obey the Spirit When the Spirit comes, unpredictable things happen. However, the spirit will not pour itself out if we are not prepared for it. When one is prompted by the spirit, how do we know it is actually from the spirit? We should ask these questions: Has this happened in the Scriptures? What has God, Jesus, and/or Apostles say about this particular prompting you are having? Is it Good? Is there any chance it can be bad? However the only way to know the way of the Spirit, is to know the Word.
- 3). Discipleship Jesus told us to "Go and make disciples." However, discipleship is almost no existence in churches today. Why? An older woman at a church in Michigan was telling me how when she started to attend a particular church, she was told that she needed to take a discipleship class. She was greatly offended because she grew up in church most of her life. She thought that she did not need discipleship because she was a "season veteran" in the Christian circles. However she took the classes and realized that she need to be in this class, because she learned more about what it means to be a follower of Christ, most about the Word of God, and how she can Go and make disciples. So I ask this question? Have you been disciplined? To answer this question you need to ask some others, "How often are you in the Word? Do you talk about Jesus to unbelievers? Have you experience spiritual growth? IF you are convicted by these three questions then you need to go through some discipleship.

These three things we need to strive for and keep close to our heart. As proverbs 3:1 says, "My son (and daughter), do not forget my teaching, but keep my commands in your heart, for they will prolong your life many years and bring you prosperity. (Pro 3:1-2 NIV) Let us be prosperous in spirit and in worship.







Ever stopped and thought about the faces of grace? "What's its appearance, what does it look like? Grace is sometimes defined as "God's Riches At Christ's Expense. Grace was the outcome for us from a horrific passage of Jesus to the cross. We know that sweet, amazing grace that pours over us as we are pardoned for our sins. We know that amazing grace when we receive or give forgiveness involving another person.

What about other pictures of grace? What about the times our situation does not look "graceful", or the outcome of our prayer is not what we hoped for or desired? What does grace look like then?

Grace may come as determination to persevere, grace may come as a faith exercise that builds strength, grace may come with a spirit of boldness that gives courage or, grace may swim through a sea of tears as God throws you a life preserver and you reach and hold tightly to it.

Grace has many faces, many expressions. We can see Jesus receiving grace from His Father in the Garden of Gethsemane after Jesus prayed three times. Jesus submitted himself to the will of God but through prayer he received the strength and courage for what was ahead (Matthew 26:36-42). Paul prayed three times for God to take away the thorn in his flesh but Paul was reminded in 2 Corinthians 12:9: "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness".

Our Lord designs many faces of grace. He makes them uniquely and perfectly for each of us. Sometimes the face of grace may look unrecognizable; that's when we should draw closer to him for clarity. He will supply that amazing grace which is abundant and sufficient!!

Don't forget to have a heart!


